- The last printed pages have the first Clue the kids get to start the game (written in plain english) and the final Congratulations Message which goes into the Treasure Chest. Lock the Treasure Chest with the combination lock after you put in the treasure and also the Congratulations Message.
- You can print from any internet computer for the next 30 days You just need your ticket number, which was emailed to you with your order.
